

HOWARD ROSENBERG

Howard Rosenberg is the Pulitzer Prize-winning former television critic for *The Los Angeles Times*.

At the University of Southern California, Rosenberg teaches critical writing and a TV symposium in the School of Cinematic Arts and news ethics in the Annenberg School of Communication and Journalism.

Publisher's Weekly gave coveted "star" status to Rosenberg's anthology, "*Not So Prime Time: Chasing the Trivial on American Television*," anointing it a "delectable book of crisp, witty and caustic criticism." His co-written non-fiction book, *No Time to Think: The Menace of Media Speed and the 24-hour News Cycle*, was called "compelling and insightful" by the *Associated Press*.

Rosenberg's new novel is *Up Yours!* (www.amazon.com), a comic mystery.

He was also author of the syndicated cartoon strip, *Airwaves*, and his numerous other honors include two National Headliner Awards for commentary.
